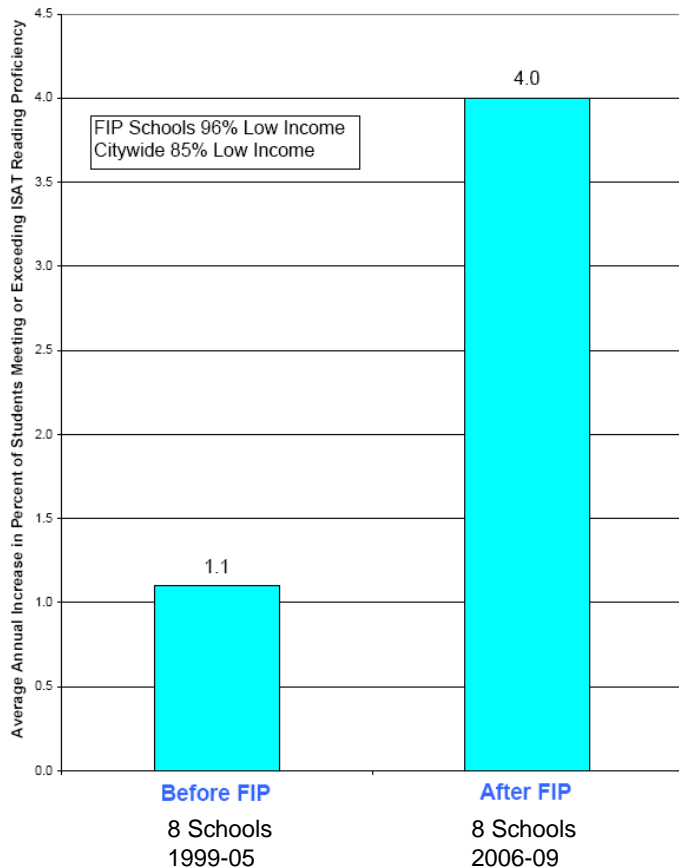




Reading Results For Eight K-8 Schools

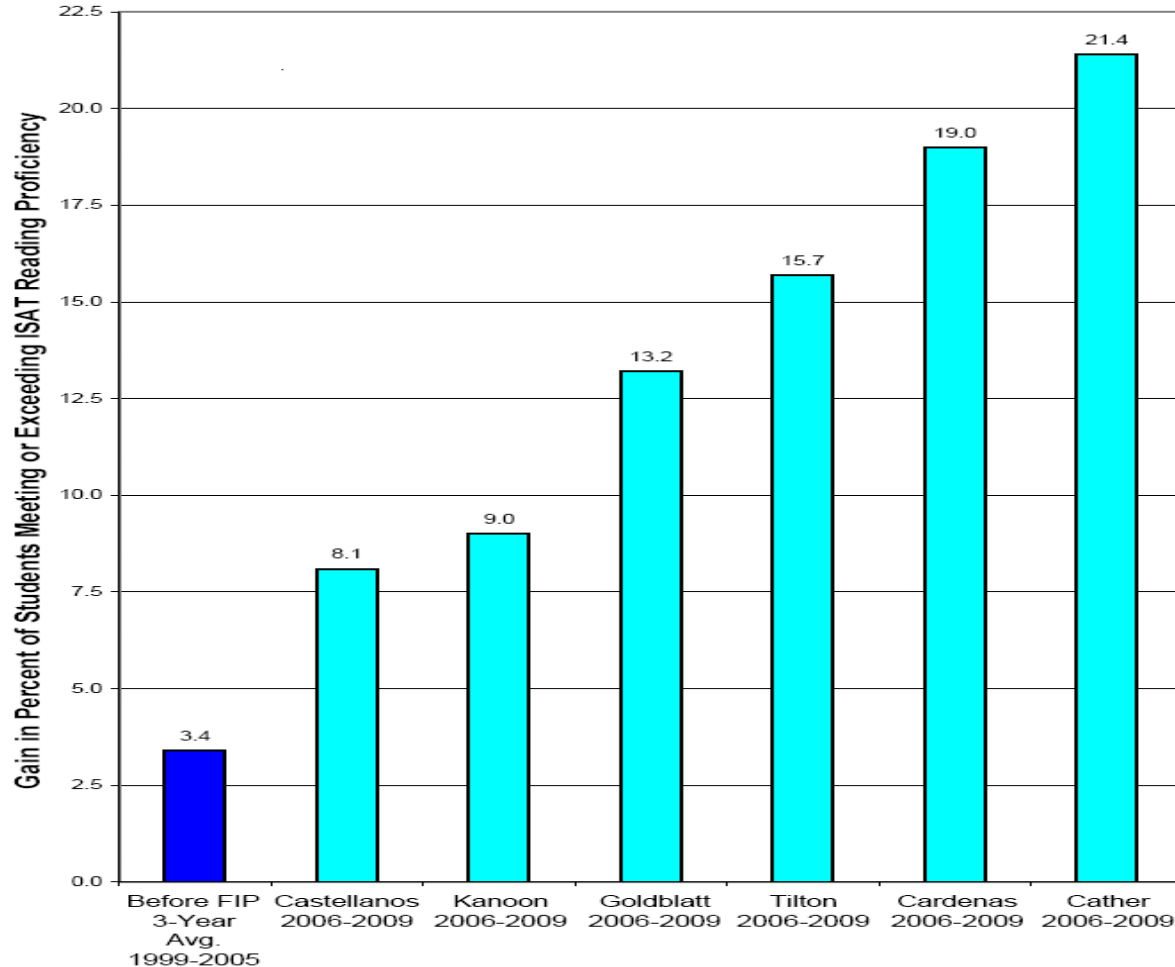
FIP Schools improve 4 times faster than before FIP ISAT Reading results before and during FIP '99-'09 (Avg. annual increase in percent of students meeting or exceeding ISAT Reading proficiency)



- In 2006, eight K-8 schools were on the CPS list to be closed or restructured.
- Over the next 3 years the 8 schools improved 4 times faster than they did before joining the Focused Instruction Process (FIP) network.
- 6 of the 8 schools ***“turned around.”*** 3 turned around in the 1st year. 2 more in the 2nd, and 1 in the 3rd year.
- Turnaround definition: More than 3x increase in ISAT score and major improvement in school culture
- 2 of the 8 were the most improved school in the city in '07 and '08: Cather and Cardenas.
- Teacher and principal satisfaction with the model was high at the end of the 1st year. It improved further at the end of the 2nd and 3rd years.
- Cost per school: Under \$150,000/year. This is less than 10% of some turnaround models.



6 FIP Schools Sustain Turnaround Gain in ISAT Reading, '06-09



Over three years the schools improve up to 6 times compared to the average 3 year gain prior to FIP
